

SINGLE SIGN ON (SSO)

What is Single Sign On?

Single Sign-On (SSO) is an authentication method that enables users to securely authenticate with multiple applications and websites by using just **one** set of credentials.

What SSO will look like for MSite

When SSO is **enabled** for your business, how you log into MSite will look a little different.

When logging in as a Project User, you will **not** be required to enter a password (*the normal **Sign In** button will be *greyed out* and you will **not** be able to select it*).

Instead, the **SSO Sign In** button/option will be available.

When using SSO Sign In you will then be required to **authenticate** your identity using your company's chosen **authenticator**.

One example of this is the **Microsoft Authenticator App**.



Please Note: If your business is not using SSO you will sign in using the current method of **email** and **password** (*the **SSO Sign In** button will be *greyed out* and you will **not** be able to select it*).
